

In Part II, the author outlines the ORDER approach to critical evaluation:- Observation- Reflection - Discussion- Evaluation - Recommendations for revisions He explains each step in the ORDER approach and provides writing and discussion ideas designed to stimulate teacher and student thinking about the critical process and how it works. The book also offers numerous hints to help teachers communicate the approach in their classes. Part III presents practical suggestions for implementing the ORDER approach in beginning- and advanced-level choreography classes. The author interweaves practical activities with theoretical considerations to help students better understand the critical process. Teachers will also learn how to handle anticultural beliefs and disagreements that arise among students in critical discussions. With Dancers Talking Dance, teachers can help students hone their critical skills and become more articulate, creative, and confident dancers. v
