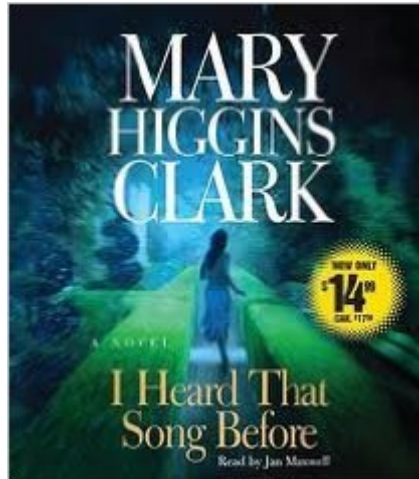

Kay Lansing, whose father worked as the family landscaper when she was six years old, overhears a conversation in the family chapel in the grounds of the Carrington mansion which, in later years, she understands to have been blackmail attempt.Beset on every side by the assumption of her now husband's guilt, Kay battles to retain her equilibrium when even her grandmother declares Peter guilty of murdering Susan Althorpe all those years ago. The fact that not one person or legal department would appear to have any motive or evidence against Peter does not prevent his being arrested and charged with murder and subsequently being tried by media.Well-written, beautifully paced, a good fast read for a lazy afternoon.*****
